YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio - Roll the drums and roll back the years!

Twenty-four professional musicians who have made history with the Youngstown State University Jazz Ensembles over the past 18 years will headline a concert at 8 p.m. Monday, March 2, in the Chestnut Room of Kilcawley Center.

The concert is free and open to the public on a first-come, first-served basis.

The newly formed YSU Alumni Jazz Ensemble will make their premiere appearance, sharing the program with current Jazz Ensembles I and II, all under the baton of Tony Leonardi of Poland, jazz director.

The Alumni Ensemble was conceived and organized by two graduates of YSU's Dana School of Music and former ensemble members, Rich Rollo and Mike Crist. Rollo, sax player and now instrumental music teacher in Warren city schools, received a Bachelor's degree from YSU in 1983, the same year Crist received his Master of Music degree here. Crist is currently a Dana School music instructor.

To assemble the grad group, letters were sent to former Jazz Ensemble members living within a 100-mile radius of Youngstown who are still active musicians.

The letters brought "yea's" from 24, who represent the history of the University's renowned jazz program.

Two alumni performers were among the original ensemble members. They are Garey Watson '71, band director at Cardinal High School in Middlefield, and Phil Wilson, '77, band director at Bluffton High School.

Wilson, along with former lead trumpet player Bill Bodine, now bassist on television's "Star Search" program, were instrumental in getting YSU Jazz Ensemble Director Leonardi to form the first band in 1969.

Leonardi, YSU '71 and '79 and a professional bass player, is associate professor of music at the Dana School of Music and plays with the Youngstown Symphony and with area jazz groups.

Featured soloists in the March 2 concert will include: James Garber, piano; John Lecce, drums; Rich Rollo, Frank Messuri and David Kana, tenor sax; John Reese and John Olsson, trombone; Jim Volenik, alto sax; Royce Hetrick, Norman Pellegrini, David Rivello and Don Stimple, trumpet.

Jazz Ensemble I will feature a new composition by sophomore trumpet major Mike Kamuf entitled "Wish You the Best."

The Dana School of Music is part of YSU's College of Fine and Performing Arts.
