YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio - Chi Sigma Iota and the Counseling Department at Youngstown State University, will sponsor a lecture on nutritional counseling by Dr. David Santoro, professor of counseling at Cleveland State University.

Dr. Santoro's lecture, entitled "Is Something Eating You or Is It Something You are Eating?" will be presented at 4 p.m. Monday, March 10, in the Ohio Room of Kilcawley Center.

The lecture is open to YSU counselors, faculty, staff, and students, and interested members of the community. Admission is \$3 except for YSU students who will be admitted free with a valid I.D.

During his lecture, Dr. Santoro will review the range of academic and social problems which may be related to improper nutrition. Assessment of biochemical imbalances and counseling interventions will also be discussed.

Chi Sigma Iota is an honor society of counseling professionals and professionals-in-training dedicated to excellence in scholarship, research and clinical practice. Its purpose is to promote and recognize exemplary attainment in the study and practice of counseling.
