YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio - Kilcawley Center's Art Gallery at Youngstown State University will feature the work of three graduating seniors March 25-April 20.

The "Annual Honors Exhibit" show, free and open to the public as well as the University community, will exhibit works of Michael Corlew of Ashtabula, graphic designer; Carolyn Dixon of Warren, photographer; and Mark Lysowski, Youngstown, who will have paintings, two ceramic murals and a metal sculpture in the show.

A reception for the artists will be held from 6-8 p.m. Friday, March 29, in the gallery.

Gallery hours are Monday and Friday, 10 a.m.-4 p.m.; Tuesday and Thursday, 10 a.m.-8 p.m.; and Saturday, 11 a.m.-3 p.m.

Corlew, who will graduate in June with a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree, majored in graphic design with a minor in history. He has had work exhibited in the annual YSU Student Show at Butler Institute of American Art, The Penguin Review; and in the Society of Illustrators Student Scholarship competition.

Dixon, whose works will include photos and photo silkscreens, majored in photography and receives her B.F.A. degree March 23. She won an Honorable Mention in the 1984 Student Show at Butler, and has photos in "Image '84" and "Landscapes" (1985) at the Trumbull Art Guild, Warren.

Lysowski will receive his B.F.A. degree in June in Studio Art. He has received honors at the Student Show at Butler and the "May Show" at the Cleveland Museum of Art.
