YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio - Youngstown State University's Office of Continuing Education/Education Outreach and The College for the 60-Plus will present a special program featuring Dr. Sally M. Hotchkiss, associate provost, dean of Graduate Studies, and professor of psychology at YSU.

The program will be held from 2-3:30 p.m. on Thursday, April 18 in Room 2068 of Kilcawley Center. Her topic will be "Psychological Aspects of Loss."

Dr. Hotchkiss has been with the university since 1968 when she joined the faculty of the Psychology Department. In 1979 she received a YSU "Distinguished Professor Award," and in 1981 she was named acting dean of the Graduate School. In 1982 she became dean and associate provost. Dr. Hotchkiss was president of the Ohio State Board of Psychology for 1982-83.

The College for the 60-Plus enables individuals who are 60 years of age or older, and who have been residents of Ohio for the past 12 months to enroll in regular credit courses at YSU on a non-credit, space-available basis, free of tuition and general fee charges. Registration for The College for the 60-Plus for Summer Quarter will be held on June 13-14 in the Office of Continuing Education/Education Outreach in Room B087, Cushwa Hall.

YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio - The Youngstown State University Office of Continuing Education will offer a six-week course, "Construction Estimating," beginning April 17.

It will provide a systematic approach to preparing an estimate for a construction project. Participants will study various methods of utilizing plans and specifications to prepare and submit bids. There will also be a comprehensive discussion of insurance and bonding.

Instructor for the on-campus course will be Herbert D. Moore of Poland, who is a designer for University Facilities at YSU.

"Construction Estimating" classes will be held from 6:30-8:30 p.m. on Wednesdays, April 17 through May 29. The fee is \$75.
