THESE VIALS ARE SMALL CYLINDERS CONTAINING VITAL INFORMATION ABOUT AN INDIVIDUAL'S SERIOUS MEDICAL CONDITION. THEY ARE ALWAYS STORED INSIDE THE REFRIGERATOR AND FUNCTION IN A SIMILAR MANNER AS A MEDICAL I.D. TAG, ALERTING SAFETY FORCES IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY.

IF YOU HAVE A SERIOUS HEALTH PROBLEM, LIVE ALONE, OR KNOW SOMEONE WHO LIVES ALONE, PICK UP A VIAL AT YSU'S CAMPUS SECURITY OFFICE, LOCATED ON SPRING STREET, JUST OFF WICK AVENUE, OR CALL THE SECURITY OFFICE FOR MORE INFORMATION AT
