

Prof. Burt Takes Leave of Absence

Professor H. N. Burt leaves his teaching post temporarily at Youngstown College January 21, to take work at Yale for his Ph. D. degree. To fill his position, Mr. John A. McCorkle of Niles has been added to the Youngstown College teaching staff.

Mr. McCorkle comes here at the beginning of the second semester January 31 and will teach history and political science. He leaves New York University where he has been on the faculty for three years.

Mr. McCorkle received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Oberlin College in 1929 and his Master of Arts degree from Princeton University in 1930. He has done graduate work at New York University and Western Reserve University. As a student he was active in debate and public speaking and a member of Delta Sigma Rho, National Honorary Forensic Fraternity. Mr. McCorkle won the Patterson Prize for Public Speaking at Oberlin where he was graduated with honors in Political Science. His major interest in this field is in Constitutional Law and Supreme Court cases.
