

Col. Wales Named New ROTC Head

Col. John Wales, a 23-year Army veteran, has succeeded Col. Richard Bestor as Professor of Military Science and head of the University's ROTC department.

Col. Wales replaced Col. Bestor after the latter was appointed a U.S. Army attache in Uruguay. Col. Wales was stationed at Fort Hood, Texas as an intelligence of-

ficer before being transferred to YU.

The new PMS was an assistant professor of military science at of Fort Leavenworth's military Ohio State, on staff and faculty school, staff officer of the Army Department in Washington and also saw service in Saudi Arabia. He is a graduate of Virginia Military Institute.

Impressed by Program

Col. Wales said he was very impressed with the ROTC program here. He praised President Howard Jones and the administrative staff for their efforts in aiding the ROTC on this campus.

He also said he was encouraged by the enthusiasm the advanced cadets have shown, and by the size of the freshmen class which is the largest in the school's history.
