

## Ellis Is Acting Dean Of Engineering School

Professor Frank Ellis has been appointed Acting Dean of the William Rayen School of Engineering by President Howard Jones to replace Dean Louis Deesz, who died suddenly last month.



In a statement to the press Dean Ellis said that his policy would be basically the same as that of Dean Deesz. He listed the addition of a night school course in engineering as part of his plans. "With the addition of new laboratories at night, the student will be able to complete a whole course in the evening," he said.

Ellis also stated that, like Dean Deesz, his chief aim will be to raise the Engineering School to a standard with schools like Case Institute, and Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

Aims of the new Dean include adding Masters degrees in Engineering and Physics to the degrees already offered by the school.
