

Dr. Low Has Book Published

Dr. Alfred D. Low, instructor of history, has just had a new book published, the title of which is "Lenin On The Question of Nationality." In the book, an attempt has been, among other things to indicate which elements of Lenin's thought on nationality have been woven into the fabric of the U.S.S.R. and in what manner.

Born in Vienna, Austria, Dr. Low came to the United States in 1939 and became a U.S. citizen in 1945. He has traveled extensively throughout Europe and Turkey.

After coming to America, he studied at Haverford College, Haverford, Pa. under the retraining project for foreign scholars sponsored by the American Friends Service Committee and he later studied at Harvard and Columbia Universities on scholarships.

He received his Ph.D. from the University of Vienna in 1936 and his Master of Arts from Columbia University in 1956.

Dr. Low has served on the faculties of Syracuse University, Wells College, and Marietta College and was visiting lecturer at New York State college for Teachers in Albany.

Dr. Low is married and has two daughters.
