

Stacy, ROTC Commander, Is Now Lieut. Colonel

Robert S. Stacy, professor of military science and tactics at Youngstown College, has been given a temporary promotion to Lieutenant Colonel, it was announced today. The promotion was one of several hundred made by the Department of the Army this month.

Colonel Stacy came to Youngstown in June of this year to organize the new Reserve Officers Training Corps unit at Youngstown College. He has been in the Army since June 1942 when he entered the service as a private. During the war he commanded an antiaircraft gun battery in Panama. He is a graduate of the Officers Advanced Course of the Artillery School at Fort Sill, Okla.
