

# Education Department Announces Changes In Enrollment Set-up

The Department of Education has announced that all students who wish to enroll for a course in Education must have his schedule countersigned by an adviser in the Education Department, in addition to the signature of an adviser in his major department provided it is not in Education. Students must have filed an application for admission to the Department of Education; this application must be approved or pending. This applies to all students who wish to follow such a course.

Applications should be filed immediately in order to avoid delay in registration for summer and fall. Application forms can be obtained in the office of the Department of Education, Annex 1, second floor.

The following requirements must be fulfilled for a student to be approved by the Department of Education. (1) Score of 34th. percentile or higher on the OSU Psychological test; (2) Score of 40th. percentile or higher on the ACE English test; (3) Prospective elementary school teachers must pass the Stanford Achievement test; (4) Scholastic point average in all college courses 1.5 or higher; (5) Prospective high school teachers should have a point average of 2.00 in their teaching fields.

Students who have not filed an application for admission to the Department of Education should not try to register for education courses. Any persons who need to take the required tests should make their appointments immediately at the Testing Office.
