Police Science 2 Yr. Program To Begin Here

A new police science program, designed to fill a gap in trained law enforcement personnel and to provide in-service training for area law departments, will be included in the fall curriculum.

The two-year program will offer 50 quarter-hours in general college courses and 40 quarter hours in specialized police training.

General education requirements include study in economics, communications, sociology, history and political science. Students completing the program will receive the title of Associate of Arts with a major in police science.

The current police science program, started in 1964, is a regular four-year course leading to an A.B. degree with a major in police science.
