JOHN G. HAGELIS, FRESHMAN, DIES IN PLANE CRASH

John George Hagelis, pre-dental freshman here, of 839 Woodland ave., was killed, shortly after noon Nov. 30, when his service-type Stearman biplane fell out of a sharp landing approach turn near Bird airport and spun to the ground.

Cause of the crash was said to be the lack of landing speed.
