MARCH 3, 1961

President Jones asked for reports from standing committees. Mr. Dykema reported on the Academic Standards Committee. Dr. Smith read the minutes of two Publications Committee Meetings and a meeting of the Curriculum Committee. Dr. Smith moved that these reports be accepted. Dr. Wilcox seconded. Motion carried.

President Jones suggested that a file of committee minutes be kept at the Library so that they would be available to members of the Senate. The suggestion was approved by Mr. George Jones, the Librarian, and by the Senate.

The Chairman announced that Honors Day will be May 9. The speaker to be Dr. Earl Anderson of Ohio State University's Education Department.

The President then called on Mr. Hahn to report to the Senate on a study he has recently completed regarding the origin of our students and a forecast of future enrollment. After explaining the origin of our present students and possible expansion of the area, he arrived at a figure of 12,000 students by the year 1970.

Mr. Hahn estimated the yearly increase in students as follows:

1961 - 7,249	1964 - 8,427	1967 - 11,014	
1962 - 7,616	1965 - 9,267	1968 - 11,451	1970 - 12,004
1963 - 7,975	1966 - 10,213	1969 - 11,671	

The Senate moved a vote of thanks for Mr. Hahn's very interesting report and asked him to prepare copies for the members of the Senate.
