Report of sub-committee on classification of students on the point basis.

It was unanimously voted that we recommend to the faculty that any student who at the end of his freshman work has a scholastic point average of less than .50 or at the end of his sophomore work has an average of less than .75 or at the end of his junior work has an average of 1.00 will not be readmitted as a regular college student.

It was unanimously voted that we recommend to the faculty that any student who at the end of a semester has received a grade of F in half or more than half of the total of semester hours for which he is registered or whose record at the end of a semester has a lower point average than would permit him to be admitted at the end of the year will be placed on probation.

It was voted that in computing grade point averages the number of semester hours in which a grade of F has been given be counted on the same basis as those for which credit has been given.

It was voted that students on probation are not eligible to extra-curricular activities.

## 3. Those eligible include: A. Those students who are regularly enrolled in Youngstown College.

- and B. Those students who have completed, satisfactorily, at least 60 hours of academic work.
- and C. The last 30 hours of this work must have been taken at Youngstown College.
- and D. The student shall have maintained at least an average of 2 points for all work taken, irrespective of the school where taken.
- 4. On questions of eligibility the final decision will rest with a board composed of the President of the College, the Deans, the Faculty Advisor of the Organization and the President of Student Council
  - 5. There shall be a Faculty Advisor and formal organization anothe discretion of the members.
    - A. There shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. They shall be chosen by open nomination and closed ballot.
    - B. The Faculty Advisor shall be chosen by the Organization, subject to appointment by the President of the College.
  - 6. The administration shall publish the membership of the organization at the beginning of the fall term and at the beginning of the February term, of the college year.
  - 7. Those students who have been members of the organization at some time through the current year shall be recognized at the commencement exercise.
  - 8. The attendance of students in classes, who are members of Delta Epsilon, is optional.
  - 9. The system for determining the point average shall be:

3 points for every hour of A

2 points for every hour of B

1 point for every hour of C

O point for every hour of D

-1 point for every hour of F

The total number of points for all college work shall be divided by the total hours of work taken.

This shall act as a temporary constitution until such time as the organization shall devise a permanent one.
