Conference Credit

Conference credit is charged as regular tuition credit as listed under Full-Time and Part-Time Students. This type of credit follows course credits as specified for particular courses of instruction in the college catalog. Conference credit is defined as credit received for actual work taken in a specific course wherein the student meets with his instructor on a pre-arranged schedule; is assigned and completes the required work of a regular student attending the full number of class sessions for the identical course. Conference work is open only to Juniors and Seniors having point averages of (2.00) or better. Conference work must also have the approval of Division or Department heads with final authority resting with the Dean of the College.

Conference credit is not to be misconstrued as credit for attendance, but for personal effort and completion of requirements. It will be resorted to only in extreme circumstances and must have the approval of the Dean of the College before registration in the course. *Application for a conference course must be made on the form provided for that purpose.*

Equivalency or Credit by Examination

A tuition fee of \$6.00 is charged for each credit hour honored for graduation when given by examination or equivalency evaluation wherein a student does not attend the regular classes for the course of instruction.

This type of credit will only be accepted through Division and Department heads on the approval of the Dean of the College.
