3. T. Miner initiated discussion on possibility of allowing a graduate student to simultaneously pursue a graduate degree and an undergraduate degree. Dean D'Isa reviewed policy on graduate students taking undergraduate courses for credit pointing out that the mechanism now exists by which a student can pursue a graduate and undergraduate degree simultaneously. He pointed out the need, however, for close advisement cooperation between the two departments involved.
