

Senate Members:

As requested at the last Senate meeting, the Academic Standards Committee is submitting in duplicated form a motion which it recommends for approval by the Senate. The motion given below was approved at a meeting of the Committee held on the 21st of April 1965, just before the North Central inspectors arrived, which explains why the minutes did not get written up until a few days ago and why the motion was not submitted before.

Mrs. Painter pointed out anomalies in the honor roll--a probation student on it. This can happen because the point index for inclusion in the Honor Roll is solely that of the preceding semester. Those whose names appear on the Honor Roll may therefore include some students whose cumulative average is quite low. She moved to recommend to the Dean the abolition of the honor roll as at present defined. Mr. Behen seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
