Congratulations! The Program Committee has accepted your 3-hour workshop proposal for presentation at the 1998 Annual Convention of the Association for Behavior Analysis. Attached is the scheduling information relevant to this event.

Let me remind you that workshops with less than five registrants will be canceled.
