

**MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
OF
BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF
YOUNGSTOWN STATE UNIVERSITY**

Tod Administration Building
Tuesday, June 1, 2004

Pursuant to notice duly given, a special meeting (the two hundred fiftieth) of the Board of Trustees of Youngstown State University convened at noon, June 1, 2004 in the Bresnahan Reception Room in Kilcawley Center. President David C. Sweet had called the special meeting on May 13, 2004 for the purpose of interviewing Atty. David Ochmann, a candidate for the position of General Counsel of Youngstown State University.

Seven trustees were present at the meeting, to-wit: Dr. Chander M. Kohli, chairperson of the board, who presided, Mr. Larry E. Esterly, Mr. William J. Bresnahan, Mr. Donald Cagigas, Dr. H. S. Wang (who arrived at 12:32 p.m.), Mr. John L. Pogue, and Ms. Millicent S. Counts. Absent were Mr. Larry D. DeJane, Mr. Scott R. Schulick and Ms. Charity A. Pappas. Also present were Atty. David Ochmann and Franklin S. Bennett, Jr., secretary to the board of trustees.

The chairperson called the meeting to order. Disposition of the minutes of the board's regular meeting held March 19, 2004, and the special meetings held April 23, May 17 and May 18, 2004 was deferred until the next regular meeting of the board.
