

ACADEMIC DEANS COUNCIL

Minutes of February 13, 1973 Meeting

Present: Vice President Edgar, Deans Aurand, Charignon, Evans (for Miller), Krill (joined meeting at 2:15), Paraska, Scriven, Vanaman, Yozwiak.

1. The Admissions Office and representative of ACT made a presentation about the services available from ACT. The presentation showed how the 1971-72 freshmen class entering Youngstown compared with national norms. The presentation also indicated the other type of research that can be done through ACT.
2. At 2:15 p.m., the regular meeting of the Deans Council was convened.
3. Minutes of February 6 were approved with Dean Aurand moving approval and Dean Charignon seconding. Motion carried.
4. Dr. Edgar distributed a memorandum from Mr. Aubrey concerning the replacement of ID cards.
5. Dr. Edgar reopened the discussion concerning articulation between two-year graduates and baccalaureate programs. Considerable discussion ensued. Dr. Edgar finally stated that he would respond to the effect that YSU is in sympathy with the objectives, also indicating that the proposed implementation steps should be carried through and would be an important element of the plan. In addition, certain other problems may be created.
6. Dean Yozwiak moved adjournment at 2:59 p.m. Dean Vanaman seconded. Motion carried.
