ACADEMIC DEANS' COUNCIL
Minutes

November 26, 1975

1. Vice President Edgar called the meeting to order at 1305.
2. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as written.
3. Dr. Scriven presented the program of orientation and registration for the Summer of 1976. He moved that the proposed dates be accepted. Seconded by Dean Charignon.
4. Dean Bleidt's Orientation-Evaluation report for Summer 1975 was distributed.
5. Dean Paraska suggested that orientation and registration be completely separated.
6. Dean McBriarty explained the objective and need for orientation.
7. Dr. Loch indicated that many of the older students requested that the "Joe College" approach to orientation be omitted from the orientation directed to them.
8. Dean Moore spoke in behalf of orientation as a University overview rather than a specific school overview.
9. Dean Miller indicated that slowdown in the registration procedure was a function of closed classes, particularly in the general education requirements group. These form a large part of first quarter freshmen study load.
10. Dean Yozwiak moved that Dean Scriven's motion be tabled. Seconded by Dean Paraska. The motion carried.
11. Dean Scriven presented a proposed interpretation of the regulations on a second Bachelor's degree. He agreed to present a rewrite of the proposal. The present situation is to accept *continue* interpretation pending a complete review of the second degree *the present* policy.
12. The proposal for the summer budget was presented by V.P. Edgar. Dr. Jonas explained the departmental and school forms sample copies of which he had previously distributed.
13. The meeting was adjourned at 1515.
