ounded in 1908, Youngstown State University originally served 160 students with about a dozen faculty members and provided expanded educational opportunity for all people—store clerks and factory managers, steel industry workers, newly arrived immigrants, women and men and both part-time and full-time learners.

This progressive spirit guided the development of the institution as it evolved from a YMCA technical institute, later as Youngstown College (1928), then as Youngstown University (1955) and, in 1967, as Youngstown State University, a member of the Ohio public higher education system.

Today, Youngstown State University is a leading comprehensive university, serving more than 12,500 full- and part-time students with 117 undergraduate programs, 50 master's degree programs, one specialist program and three doctoral degree programs. There are approximately 400 full-time faculty and nearly

650 full-time professional and support staff members in administrative departments and eight colleges across campus.

In partnership with schools and the corporate and non-profit communities, Youngstown State University promotes diversity and excellence in teaching, research and service to increase the educational attainment and economic and environmental vitality of the region.

Throughout its history, Youngstown State University has been cited as an innovative educational leader. It has also been recognized through numerous awards—both in academics and athletics—as one of the best urban, public, comprehensive universities in the United States.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER



Pamela Browner White

Pamela Browner White was born in Quonset Point, Rhode Island, to James R. Brame, a naval officer and one of the first African American commercial airline pilots in the United States, and his wife, Antoinette, a native of Pensacola, Florida. In 1978, after graduating from Central Bucks East High School in Buckingham, Pennsylvania, White began her college work at Pepperdine University in Malibu, California. She left Pepperdine in 1981 and after a brief career as an international model, she returned to the United States and transferred to Youngstown State University in Youngstown, Ohio. In 1987, she earned her Bachelor's degree in Communications with a minor in Marketing.

After graduation, White began working for WYTV-33, an ABC affiliate in Youngstown as a reporter and noon anchor. Soon thereafter, she became director of public relations for Browning Ferris Industries, a global solid waste company. In 1998, after several promotions within BFI, she joined Philadelphia Newspapers, Inc., which operated the award winning *Philadelphia Inquirer* and the *Daily News*, as vice president of public affairs. In 2001, she accepted a new role in the financial sector with Citizens Bank, a commercial bank operating more than 1,500 branches across a 12-state region. As senior vice president of corporate affairs, White served as the Mid-Atlantic region's key spokesperson, director of the bank's foundation and the lead officer for community reinvestment activities.

In 2009, White was named SVP of public affairs and government relations for the Philadelphia Eagles, becoming the first African American woman senior vice president

in the National Football League. In 2011, she moved into the healthcare sector as the SVP of public affairs at Cancer Treatment Centers of America, a network of five cancer treatment centers throughout the United States. In 2016, White joined the American Board of Internal Medicine, a national nonprofit dedicated to certifying physicians to demonstrate to the public that they are armed with the knowledge, skills and attitude essential for excellent patient care in a continuously changing world.

As a senior communications executive, White's entire career has focused on building strong and positive brand images for prominent corporations across diverse industries. Her expertise in the areas of corporate and crisis communications, public affairs and government relations has enabled her to successfully lead growth-enabling initiatives for each of her past employers.

Dedicated to giving back to her community and making a difference in the lives of young women and men, White founded a workforce movement called WorkReady Philadelphia. In concert with the dedicated leaders of Philadelphia Youth Network, WorkReady was designed to encourage business leaders across the Philadelphia region to invest in the city's public school students, inviting them into the workplace as interns. Since its inception nearly 160,000 work experiences were provided to Philadelphia public school students.

White has served on a number of corporate and civic boards, including Healthcare Improvement Foundation, African American Museum of Philadelphia, Widener University, Cancer Treatment Centers of America and Philadelphia Workforce Investment Board. Her career accomplishments have earned her a number of prestigious awards, including: Pennsylvania Top 50 Women in Business; *Philadelphia Business Journal* Woman of Distinction; Thurgood Marshall Award of Excellence; The Salvation Army Eliza Shirley Women in Leadership Award; the Girls Inc. of Greater Philadelphia Strong, Smart and Bold Award; and the NAACP's President's Award-Beverly Hills.

For more than 12 years, White chaired the Marian Anderson Award, honoring the legendary operatic artist Marian Anderson. The award recognizes artist humanitarians who, like Ms. Anderson, used their art to change the world. Honorees included luminaries such as Oprah Winfrey, Richard Gere, Sidney Poitier, Harry Belafonte and Maya Angelou.

White credits her family's stalwart commitment to excellence and hard work to her success. White resides in Philadelphia with her husband, Jeremiah J. White, Jr.



ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of those worn in medieval times by students and professors. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, somber black garb became the norm, and it is primarily in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing graduate degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; olive for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. International degrees do not always follow this protocol.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period.

Recipients of University Honors receive golden honor cords placed around the shoulders. Honors College graduates wear a specially minted medallion on a white ribbon to denote their academic achievement.

Graduating students who serve or have served in the Armed Forces are invited to wear red, white and blue Patriot cords in recognition of their service to our country.

THE UNIVERSITY CEREMONIAL MACE

The ceremonial mace has its roots in ancient Rome. During the Middle Ages, the types of maces—one a scepter and symbol of royal authority, the other a weapon—gradually evolved into a symbol of lawful power and regal authority. Beginning in fourteenth-century Europe, the academic mace became part of the pomp and ceremony of university commencements, denoting the authority of universities to confer academic degrees.

The Youngstown State University mace was designed and crafted by a collaborative team that included YSU faculty, students, alumni and area K-12 art educators under the leadership of YSU professor Greg Moring.

THE PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION

This is a one-of-a-kind medallion that bears an embossment of the Youngstown State University seal on each of the small elements and on the large central piece. On the back of the central medallion are engraved the names of the University's past presidents.

The presidential medallion was designed and created out of sterling and bronze by Wendell August Forge of Grove City, Pennsylvania.

THE YOUNGSTOWN STATE UNIVERSITY SEAL

The University's official seal was adopted in 1936. Designed by a student, the seal includes a torch, quills, wings, a globe and the Latin words animus liberatus. In simple terms, those words summarize the transformation—or liberation—that occurs on this campus countless times each day. In English, they are translated The Mind Freed, or The Spirit Freed.
