DOCTOR OF MILITARY SCIENCE

BRIGADIER GENERAL ROBERT G. LYNN, a 1954 graduate of Youngstown State University, is Deputy Commanding General for Readiness of the U.S. Army Communications-Electronics Command at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey. He is the first graduate of the University's Army Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) to be promoted to the rank of general.

A native of New Brighton, Pennsylvania, General Lynn attended YSU (then Youngstown College) from 1950 to 1954, playing both varsity football and varsity basketball. He was awarded the Bachelor of Science degree and commissioned a second lieutenant in the Air Defense Artillery Reserve in 1954. Prior to entering active duty service, he taught school in Boardman for one academic year.

During his 27 years as a career officer, General Lynn has served at every level of the Department of the Army. In addition to many field and staff positions at posts in the United States, he has also served three tours of duty in South Vietnam, as

well as assignments in the Dominican Republic, Okinawa, Thailand, Japan and Hawaii. His posts have ranged from a staff position in the Pentagon to a batallion command with the elite 101st Airborne Division in Vietnam, and have included duty with such other noted units as the XVIII Airborne Corps and the 1st Cavalry Division.

A Signal Corps officer, General Lynn is a graduate of the Signal Officer Career Course. He is also a graduate of the Air Defense Artillery Battery Officers Course, the Command and General Staff College, and the Army War College.

He has received numerous awards, including the Bronze Star Medal with four oak leaf clusters, the Air Medal with five oak leaf clusters, the Meritorious Service Medal with two oak leaf clusters, the Army Commendation Medal with oak leaf cluster, the Joint Service Commendation Medal, the Legion of Merit, and the Defense Superior Service Medal.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia

which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of **University Honors** will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
