THE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER
and
CANDIDATE FOR THE HONORARY DEGREE
DOCTOR OF LAWS

DONALD W. MC GOWAN is chairman of the board and president of Ohio Bancorp and its subsidiary, The Dollar Savings and Trust Company. A lifelong resident of Youngstown, he has been a leader in the local business community, and made significant contributions to many civic organizations.

Mr. McGowan attended Youngstown College in 1944 and 1945. He joined the staff of The Dollar Savings and Trust Company in 1946 as a teller under the GI training bill and has been with the bank ever since, receiving a degree from the University of Wisconsin School of Banking in 1953. He became bank president in 1977 and chairman of the board and president in 1985.

In 1982, Mr. McGowan led the formation of the area's first bank holding company, still the only locally-owned entity of its kind in Youngstown. Known as Ohio Bancorp, the holding company has five subsidiaries, of which The Dollar Savings and Trust Company is the lead institution.

Mr. McGowan currently serves as trustee to a number of area organizations, including Stambaugh Auditorium, the Buckeye Youth Foundation, the Community Improvement Corporation and the Mahoning Valley Economic Development Corporation. He heads the finance committee of the Western Reserve Care System, and served as chairman of the board of the Youngstown Area Chamber of Commerce in 1984 and 1985. In the 1980-81

campaign year, he presided over the fund-raising efforts of United Way in Youngstown. The Mahoning Valley Economic Development Corporation named him "Man of the Year" in 1984. The next year he was named "King of the Realm" by the Oldtimers Baseball Association for his efforts on behalf of local athletic activities.

Over a 15-year period, Mr. McGowan shared his fiscal expertise with the larger community as an instructor in banking and real estate for the Youngstown Chapter of the American Institute of Banking and the YSU Office of Continuing Education.

Long a supporter of Youngstown State University, Mr. McGowan lent his energies to the Alumni Association's 1984 and 1985 Distinguished Citizen Award programs as an area chairperson. He also served on the All-Sports Complex campaign, a primary source of funds for the University's Stambaugh Stadium.

At a dinner held in his honor on June 19, 1987, the Alumni Association conferred on Mr. McGowan the Distinguished Citizen Award, the symbol of highest distinction given annually to a leader in the local community. In citing him for his contributions to numerous public and private enterprises, Alumni Association directors stated that his civic and economic involvement "has placed him in the forefront of efforts to revitalize the economic base of the area."

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia

which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of **University Honors** will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
