**THE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER
and
CANDIDATE FOR THE DEGREE
HONORARY DOCTOR OF LAWS**

WARREN P. WILLIAMSON, JR. first took to the airwaves at the age of 13, when he built his first wireless transmitter out of assorted parts. A native of Youngstown, he established his own amateur wireless station in the city, and in 1918 passed a government exam for his first official operator's license. After serving as a radio operator in the U.S. Army Signal Corps from 1918 to 1919, he returned to the local area to work at Republic Steel Corporation.

In 1926, Williamson was granted a federal license to operate radio station WKBN, which broadcast at a power of 7½ watts from Williamson's Southside home. In 1930, WKBN became an affiliate of the CBS network, added FM broadcasting in 1947 and television in 1953.

Williamson has been active in a variety of civic and professional organizations, most notably the Youngstown Board of Education, having served 27 years, 18 of those as president. He directed the establishment of the Choffin Career Center, the building of ten new schools and improvements and additions to many others.

He served as president of the Mahoning Valley Historical Society and the Youngstown Area Development Corporation. He has served on the board of directors of the Mahoning National Bank and the South Side Merchants and Civic Association, as well as the executive committee of the Youngstown Citizens' Planning Council.

Among his many honors are the Eagles' Club Humanitarian Award, the Youngstown Area Jaycees' Frank Purnell Award, the Chamber of Commerce Award for civic leadership, and the "King of the Realm" award of the Baseball Town - USA Old-timers.

In 1981, Mr. Williamson donated 2,000 shares of WKBN Broadcasting Corporation stock to the Youngstown State University Educational Foundation for the support of academic programs at YSU. In recognition of his gift, the University trustees approved a resolution naming YSU's School of Business Administration after him. The building that houses the School was also renamed Williamson Hall.

Mr. Williamson's generous support of the University has provided for two fellowships awarded annually to eligible graduate students through the Warren P. Williamson, Jr. Foundation. Mr. Williamson has also made possible the Williamson Symposium, a lecture series that brings noted business professionals to campus for extended interactions with students and faculty.

Mr. Williamson has two sons, Warren P. Williamson, III, president of WKBN Broadcasting and Joseph D. Williamson, vice president of broadcasting operations at the station. His wife the former Isabel DeNio, and a daughter, Mrs. Barbara Stewart, are deceased. Mr. Williamson, now retired, is a Youngstown resident and has a winter home in Florida.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities — Bologna, Paris, Oxford — the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern-day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and

Universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the masters gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of University Honors will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
