THE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER and CANDIDATE FOR THE DEGREE HONORARY DOCTOR OF SCIENCE

When today's commencement speaker, Ron Parise was growing up in Warren, Ohio, he dreamed of taking a ride into space. Now, a few years and few academic degrees later, he's seen his wish come true—twice.

As a payload specialist aboard the space shuttle Columbia in 1990, Dr. Parise was in charge of the Astro telescope. In 1995, Parise went aloft again to conduct experiments in space with the Astro Observatory. In both instances, the equipment being used was designed to observe the ultraviolet light emitted by various objects in space.

Parise is currently manager of the Advanced Astronomy Programs Division of Computer Sciences Corp. in Silver Spring, Md. He is also a member of the research team that designed and constructed the telescopes that form the Astro payload. Astro is the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's shuttle-borne observatory designed to examine the universe in greater depth and detail than ever before using ultraviolet and X-ray technologies.

In 1985, Parise was selected as one of the payload specialists to operate the Astro equipment on a NASA Spacelab mission. His first flight, originally planned for March, 1986, was planned around observation of Halley's Comet in orbit. The explosion of the Challenger shuttle early in 1986 put the entire shuttle program—and Parise's mission—on hold. The Astro mission was rescheduled for 1990 and, after numerous delays due to

hydrogen leaks, was launched in December of that year.

During the 1990 mission, Parise and his colleagues became the first astronomers to operate telescopes in space. They observed 135 objects, including double stars, star clusters, galaxies, Jupiter, Comet Levy, and the 1987 Supernova. Observations made during the March 1995 mission show the first definitive detection of primordial helium, confirming a critical prediction of the Big Bang theory of cosmology.

Astronomers will be analyzing the results of the two Astro missions for years in an attempt to better understand the birth, life, and death of stars and galaxies. Dr. Parise is a member of the research team now conducting this analysis.

Ron Parise graduated from Youngstown State University in 1973 with a Bachelor of Science in physics and astronomy and minors in geology and mathematics. He earned a doctorate in astronomy from the University of Florida. Parise has been a licensed ham radio operator since the age of 11 and has been piloting private airplanes since he was a teenager. While at YSU, he was active in the Mahoning Valley Astronomical Society, the Society of Physics Students, and the physics honorary Sigma Pi Sigma. He worked as a student in the Department of Physics and Astronomy, assisting in Planetarium shows and running the telescope during public nights at the observatory.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities-Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern-day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown

State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has a vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirement. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The recessional at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of University Honors will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
