Commencement Speaker and candidate for the degree Honorary Doctor of Science

In the spring of 1997, the world was treated to a rare and wonderful sight that hung in the sky for weeks. As YSU student Christine Hutson put it:

"I saw a comet . . . A wandering star, A mist of light, A dusty fingerprint On the velvet night."

The comet bore the name of its co-discoverers, Alan Hale and today's commencement speaker, **Thomas Bopp**. Hale is a professional astronomer who lives in New Mexico. Tom Bopp is a former Youngstown State University business student with an amateur's love for the stars.

Tom Bopp was born in Denver, Colorado, and moved to Youngstown with his family when he was two. When he was three, Bopp writes, his father held him on his lap on the porch steps while they watched a large meteor shower, and thus began a lifelong fascination with things celestial. Through his childhood, his father taught him about the constellations, the Aurora Borealis, and the planets. Over the years, he says, he spent many summer nights in the yard watching for "shooting stars" and dreaming of space travel.

After graduating from Chaney High School in 1967, Bopp entered the Air Force. He was stationed in the Philippines, where he was able to observe the "green flash" phenomenon on several occasions. (The green flash can be observed at sunset only under perfect conditions.) In his last year of service he was stationed in Tuscon, Arizona, where he met his wife Charlotte.

After his tour of duty, he moved back to Ohio and enrolled in business administration at Youngstown State University. Of his elective courses, astronomy was his favorite. There he met Dr. Warren Young and Dr. Edwin Bishop, who introduced him to the Mahoning Valley Astronomical Society. The club had a 16" Newtonian reflector, which Bopp put to good use. He was joined in his deep space explorations by fellow YSU student Ron Parise, who later became a NASA payload specialist working with the ultraviolet Astro telescope system.

In 1980, Bopp moved to Phoenix. He attended "star parties" with several clubs in the Phoenix area. Then he began observing with the North Phoenix Alternative Astronomical Society. It was on one of their observing sessions on July 22, 1995, that Bopp spotted "a fuzzy object" in the sky. Two days after reporting his sighting, Bopp received a call from astronomer Alan Hale, who had simultaneously discovered the comet from the driveway of his Cloudcroft, New Mexico home.

Comet Hale-Bopp has been called "the comet of the century," because of its extraordinary size—three times that of Haley's Comet—its first-ever sodium tail, and its long and well-publicized visit. And the comet's arrival at the end of the Christian millenium and its association with the Heaven's Gate cult will assure its place in American folklore.

Tom Bopp has begun a public-speaking tour to share his love of the stars with a wider audience. Last spring, he appeared before an overflow crowd at YSU, with Hale-Bopp hovering in the sky outside.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities— Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern-day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia which is

different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has a vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirement. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The recessional at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of University Honors will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
