THE HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

ROBERT F. DOOLITTLE

Robert F. Doolittle is vice chairman of the Ohio Board of Regents, counsel for the Cleveland law firm of Baker, Hostetler and Patterson, and a director of The Youngstown Sheet and Tube Company. He has been a member of the Ohio Board of Regents since 1963 and vice chairman of the Board since 1966. In 1967 he became counsel for the Cleveland firm and a director of Sheet and Tube. Mr. Doolittle joined The Youngstown Sheet and Tube Company in 1952 as assistant general counsel and assistant secretary, becoming general counsel and corporation secretary in 1959, and vice president in 1964. Prior to that time he was engaged as counsel for Baldwin-Lima-Hamilton Corporation and had been a vice president of that firm. He was educated at Harvard University receiving his A.B. degree, magna cum laude, and his LL.B. degree from that institution. Mr. Doolittle is a member of the advisory council of the Ohio Water Commission, chairman of the advisory task force on financing State Water Management Plan, and the Governor's Commission on Emergency Resource Planning. He is a trustee and president of the Ohio Manufacturers Association, and a member of the following organizations and associations: the American Judicature Society; the American, New York, Ohio and Mahoning County Bar Associations; the National Association of Manufacturers; the American Iron and Steel Institute; Phi Delta Phi professional law fraternity; and Phi Beta Kappa. He is also a former director of the Youngstown Symphony Society.

Academic Regalia and Ceremony

Whether the gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by civilians or ecclesiastics is still unknown. It is true that teachers in early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—were priests or monks, and that most university students were theological students who also wore gowns to the lectures they attended. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. Needless to say, the hoods worn in academic processions today are more colorful than those worn in earlier times.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. For instance, the lining of the hoods placed this evening over the heads of the recipients of the honorary degrees is cardinal and white, the colors of Youngstown State University. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the Doctor's degree, medium for the Master's, short for the Bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The Bachelor's gown is worn closed; the Master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the Doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are

of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the Doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The Doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it represents a book as carried by scholars. Still another is that it stems from the privilege accorded to freemen in Rome when slavery existed there; slaves were forced to go bareheaded. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all Masters' and Bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels reflect the degree received, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods. The tassels worn by Doctors may be black or of gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in Commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the trustees, the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of *University Honors* will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
