**BISHOP JAMES W. MALONE**

### **BIOGRAPHICAL SUMMARY**

The Most Reverend James W. Malone, Bishop of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Youngstown, is a religious leader who has also gained distinction as a scholar, educator, civic figure, and humanitarian. A native of Youngstown, Bishop Malone earned his bachelor's degree from St. Mary's Seminary, Cleveland, Ohio, and his master's degree and doctorate from Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C. He was ordained a priest in 1945, consecrated a bishop and appointed Auxiliary Bishop in 1960, named Apostolic Administrator in 1966, and appointed Bishop of Youngstown in 1968. He served as Superintendent of Schools for the Diocese of Youngstown from 1950-65, and during that time was active locally as a board member of such civic organizations as the Child Guidance Center, the Red

Cross, Rotary, the Mayor's Human Relations Commission, and the Fair Employment Practices Committee. From 1963-65, Bishop Malone attended the sessions of the Vatican Council and as a result became actively involved in the national and international ecumenical and organizational activities of the Roman Catholic Church. He has served as chairman of the Christian Formation Committee and the Committee on Pastoral Councils, and as a member of the American Bishops' Committee on Ecumenism, the Administrative Committee of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops, and the Committee for International Conversations with Methodists. He is Bishop Moderator of the National Newman College Apostolate for Catholic Students and was recently elected chairman of the Catholic Bishops of Ohio.

## ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

Whether the gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by civilians or ecclesiastics is still unknown. It is true that teachers in early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—were priests or monks, and that most university students were theological students who also wore gowns to the lectures they attended. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. Needless to say, the hoods worn in academic processions today are more colorful than those worn in earlier times.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. For instance, the lining of the hood placed this evening over the head of the recipient of the honorary degree is cardinal and white, the colors of Youngstown State University. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the Doctor's degree, medium for the Master's, short for the Bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia

which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The Bachelor's gown is worn closed; the Master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the Doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the Doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The Doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it represents a book as carried by scholars. Still another is that it stems from the privilege accorded to freemen in Rome when slavery existed there; slaves were forced to go bareheaded. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all Masters' and Bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels reflect the degree received, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods. The tassels worn by Doctors may be black or of gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in Commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the trustees, the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of **University Honors** will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
