I. There were no corrections offered for the Minutes of July 16, 1991.

II. A. Travel Policy:

Rick Glunt, Executive Director, Finance, reviewed changes in the policy, as follows:

- 7.1 Approval changed from President to XDF.
- 7.3 No categories, either percent of dollars agreed upon in advance (or % "up to x dollars").
- 7.5.2. New, rejection by clerk.
- 7.6.3. Use best judgement on method of travel, but submit comparison.
- 7.7.1. Change meals from 4/5/11 to 5/6/15
- 7.7.7. Change from 25 to 30.

Discussion: Changes probably next July. Submit suggestions to Rick (XDF) early. May go to travel agency, maybe to individual "travel cards."

B. Communication soon on refund policy in case of strike.

Yiannaki requested review of courses for SB 140, 33 new students enrolled for fall, 16 continuing. Estimates loss in order of \$20,000. Ruggles points out that cable TV, possible soon, can possibly replace some of the courses.

Penguin Sampler Day will be November 9.

Mapley announced that the Transfer Module had been accepted by the review sub-committee, so that some means of enlightening advisors, particularly faculty, should be provided. Hotchkiss suggested a faculty development workshop, they will discuss.

  YSU/YSU-OEA fact-finding complete, report by Sunday.

- C. Ed.D. proposal is at OBOR for distribution and comment. M.S. in Computer Science, preliminary report to RAGS. Ph.D. in Clinical Biomedical Sciences, no apparent motion. M.S.N. final proposal is in preparation.
