I. Minutes of March 17, 1992 were approved.

II. Budget Information

- a. In May we should see a 15% reduction. General information about the budget was discussed. Uncertainty is the mode.
- b. Degree Audit Update: General update on registration problems. Transfer module was discussed.

III. New Business

- a. Appeals procedure for Transfer Module was presented by Yiannaki. Mapley presented concerns about institutional autonomy and the Transfer Module issue. There is a fear that the concept will be extended beyond the basic concept. Further clarification will be sought.
- b. H.B. 55 was presented and a discussion about potential admission problems followed. It was generally agreed that our current admission criteria would exclude non-diploma holders.
- c. Sweetkind expressed a concern about computer registration. Chairs are complaining about clerical workload. Who is going to do the work is still an issue. Mapley confirmed awkwardness of the system. It takes a lot of time.
- d. Sweetkind questioned the use of furlough of work time.

IV. Discussion of budget procedure and preparation was given. The 7-3.3.3 approach was defined.
