YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio - Youngstown State University's Department of Counseling, which had received provisional accreditation last fall, has received full accreditation for its programs in school (kindergarten through 12th grade) and in community counseling.

The Council on Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs, accrediting body of the American Association of Counseling and Development, granted the approval, which runs until 1992.

The department was the first in this state, and one of 40 nationwide, to receive national accreditation for its school and community programs.

Dr. David W. Cliness of Poland is chairman of the department, which is part of YSU's School of Education.

YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio - Nearly 600 area teachers and school administrators have been participating in 37 graduate workshops at this year's "Summer of Growth" at Youngstown State University.
