YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio - Working women will be the focus of a full-day seminar offered by the Office of Continuing Education at Youngstown State University.

"Women Communicating on the Job--How Effective Are You?" will be held May 20 at Holiday Inn North off Belmont Avenue.

The seminar will identify and interpret non-verbal behaviors women may encounter in job related settings. Through experimental exercises and group interaction, participants will learn different and effective ways of expressing and negotiating conflict, as well as learning to become better listeners.
