Historical Background

Courses in Human Ecology (then called Home Economics) started being offered at Youngstown College/YSU in the College of Arts and Sciences during the 1942-1943 academic year. The program offered the classes as electives for students, a growing female population during WWII while men were drafted off to war. It offered four lower division courses (Food and Nutrition, Food Preparation, Clothing Appreciation, and Clothing Selection and Construction) and four upper division courses (Child Psychology, Psychology of Adolescence, Psychology of Marriage and Family Relations, and Personality and Mental Hygiene). Classes were taught by only one part-time instructor, Ms. Viola Paroz.¹

In 1954, Youngstown College President Howard Jones announced an expansion of programs for women at the college which included home economics.² It was following year that the college (soon to be University) offered a major in home economics and the program developed into a full-fledged department led by Wilma Alene Brown. Courses were expanded and added to the curriculum to include six lower division courses and fifteen upper division courses. The courses led to degrees in the Bachelor of Arts in Home Economics, the Bachelor of Science in Education, for those who wished to teach home economics in secondary school, and a Bachelor of Science with the major in food and nutrition, for those who wished for careers in dietetics or nutrition.³

The department stayed with the College of Arts and Sciences until 1971, when it was transferred to the new Technical and Community College. Here, the department grew and had expanded facilities to include a household facilities lab, a bakery, an experimental cookery lab, a weaving and crafts room, a clothing lab with dressing rooms, a common room for entertaining and classroom experience, storage space and a preparation room. New courses were added to include an orientation class, demonstration techniques class, an activity analysis class, and several child nutrition classes.⁴ The Technical and Community College led the way for the development of an Associate Degrees for Child Care Technology, and Dietary Technology as well as the continuation of Bachelors of Science for Food and Nutrition, General Home Economics and Home Economic Education degrees.⁵

In the 1980s, there was another curriculum expansion for the department. A cross between marketing and home economics combined to form a new major in Fashion Retailing in 1986.⁶ In 1989, the state of Ohio was having a big push for tourism. As a result, the university started to offer a two-year-degree in the field of Hospitality Management.⁷ During

the 1990s, the College of Applied Sciences and Technology (the Technical and Community College) was reorganized and became the College of Health and Human Services. Home Economics was a major component of the college and was renamed to Human Ecology.⁸

Currently, the department offers three Associate Degrees in Applied Sciences in Early Childhood Associate/Pre-K, Dietetic Technician, and Hospitality Management and six degrees of Bachelor of Science in Applied Sciences are offered in the fields of Didactic Program in Dietetics, Coordinated Program in Dietetics, Family and Consumer Studies, Family and Consumer Sciences Instructor, Merchandising: Fashion and Interiors, and Hospitality Management.⁹

Scope and Content

The collection dates from 1980-2008 with the bulk of the collection from the mid-1980s-1990s. It is organized into three series: Minutes, Reports and Subject Files. Minutes include departmental minutes and minutes for the Coordinated Undergraduate Program in Dietetics along with their subcommittee minutes. This series dates from 1985-2002. The reports contain annual reports from the department as well as reports for accreditation such as self-studies. Most of these are dated in the 1980s and were sent to the American Dietetic Association for approval. The subject files contain material from the Institutional accrediting agency of the Higher Learning Commission from 2007.

Colophon

This collection was processed from March to April 2019 by Lisa Marie Garofali, assistant archivist, with a M.A. in History. No formal accession paperwork for the collection was provided. It is assumed the collection was transferred to the Archives and Special Collection in 2011, when Ben Blake was responsible for accessions. The collection was partially rummaged through by him and sense of original order was lost. Much of the collection was

in original binders until he rehoused the material in unmarked folders, making it a guessing game of what folders were continued into other folders. One box of the collection was weeded through and, according to IUC PER 2000 code of the Records Retention Schedule, deaccessioned. Those materials were applications for faculty positions and information from search committees. The collection also contained course catalogs and an alumni directory. These were disregarded due to duplication already in the Archives and Special Collections. Update: September 2019 – Various materials were found as records transferred from the department. The following Series were added: Hospitality Management, Human Ecology, Faculty, Photographs, Discs, Scrapbook, and Resolutions. Update: February 2020 – two extra boxes for this collection were found. Most of the material was added to the Human Ecology series. A new series of Events was added. Since this is the third time material was added, series were kept in their own boxes to make it easier to add future material (the only exception is the photograph, disc and events series).

It is interesting to note the change of department name from Home Economics to Human Ecology during June 1993. The Coordinated Undergraduate Program in Dietetics minutes are made up of several subcommittee and date from 1985-1993. The Coordinated Undergraduate Program in Dietetics contains subcommittee minutes of The Council for Dietetic Education, The Advisory Committee, Admissions and Retention Committee, and the Clinical Coordinating/Curriculum Committee.
