## **Descriptive Summary**

- Title:** Campus Planning and Community Development Records, 1976-2008
- Creator:** This collection was created under the direction of Hunter Morrison who was hired under YSU President David Sweet.
- Extent:** **8.75** Cubic feet or 7 boxes
- Abstract:** Collection pertains to Hunter Morrison's work as director of Campus Planning and Community Development. He was a key person in helping develop the YSU Master Plan (later known as the YSU Centennial Plan) and was also hired by the city of Youngstown to help with the Youngstown 2010 planning. He was also involved in regional activities and organizations.

## Historical Background

The Campus Planning and Community Development (also known as the Campus Master Plan and Community Partnership) did not exist without Hunter Morrison. The department was listed as an official campus department in 2009; however, the work of the department had existed prior to that date through Hunter Morrison, who was hired in 2002.

Hunter Morrison's hire at Youngstown State University was unique because both the city of Youngstown and YSU shared his employment. In February of 2002, YSU President David Sweet announced that Morrison was hired to help oversee YSU's Master Plan/Centennial Plan and while also assisting city officials with their own planning process so that one plan may complement the other. Originally he was to work two days a week, one for YSU and one for the city.<sup>1</sup> That however changed shortly afterwards and in 2003, he was named the Director of the Center for Urban and Regional Studies of YSU. Holding this position until 2009 when he developed the Campus Planning and Community Development/Partnership Department. This fit his intended purpose to devote most of his time to campus planning rather than directing Urban Studies. The following is a description of his profession background from the Industrial Information Institute for Education, Inc. in 2004.

The Center for Urban and Regional Studies was established by the University (YSU) for the purpose of undertaking applied research addressing issues of urban and regional development and providing technical assistance to local government, social service organizations, and businesses. Mr. Morrison is also a Senior Fellow in Urban Design at Kent State University's Urban Design Center.

Prior to assuming these positions, Mr. Morrison was Director of the Cleveland City Planning Commission and was responsible for overseeing the City's planning, zoning, design review, and capital improvements programming. He served in this capacity since 1981, making him one of the longest-serving big-city planning directors in the country. Mr. Morrison was responsible for Civic Vision 2000, a \$3 million initiative that resulted in the comprehensive updating of the City's Downtown Plan, Citywide Plan, and Zoning Code. The Civic Vision program was awarded the 1992 American Planning Association National Planning Award for Comprehensive Planning.

Under his direction, the department was responsible for the development of master plans for North Coast Harbor District, site of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and the Cleveland Browns Stadium; the Playhouse Square Theatre District, site of the country's second largest performing arts center; and the Gateway Sports District, home of Jacobs Field and the Gund Arena. The Gateway project was awarded an Urban Design Citation from Progressive Architecture in 1990, an Honor Award for urban design from the American Society of Landscape Architects in 1991, and the AIA Urban Design Award in 1996.

Prior to joining the City of Cleveland in 1980, Mr. Morrison worked for the Hough Area Development Corporation, a neighborhood development organization in Cleveland; for private consulting firms in Boston, and for the cities of Nairobi and New York. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in City Planning and Political Science from Yale College, a Masters in City Planning from the Harvard Graduate School of Design; and an Executive Masters in Business Administration from Cleveland State University. Mr. Morrison was awarded the American Institute of Architects 1997 Thomas Jefferson Award for Design in the Public Sector.

Mr. Morrison has served on the Cleveland Landmarks Commission and the Ohio State Historic Site Preservation Advisory Board. He has been a member and has served as president of the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency, the 5-county Greater Cleveland metropolitan planning organization. He has taught at the graduate level at the Harvard Graduate School of Design and at Cleveland State University's Maxine Goodman Levin College of Urban Affairs.<sup>2</sup>

## **Scope and Content**

This collection is kept in the original order determined by Hunter Morrison. Everything is alphabetized. Therefore in order to determine series, much of it was kept vague to keep the original order. Most of the collection deals with urban development for the area of Northeastern Ohio, specifically Youngstown and Cleveland areas. The bulk of the dates are 2000-2007 with a few publications dated prior which were used for references. Since Hunter Morrison was hired by the city of Youngstown and YSU, his work in these areas is included in its own series. Much of Morrison's work mentions Cleveland, Akron and other areas are included in the first series as well as items of interest to him.

## **Colophon**

This collection was acquired through Ben Blake, head archivist at YSU from 2010-2012. It appears that prior to the arrival to the archives, the collection was kept in file cabinets or drawers. The collection was put into acid free boxes and remained there until processed, when acid free folders were provided for materials. After processing, the collection was placed on Row 13, Bay 9 Shelf 1-3 with the oversize materials located on the top of the shelving unit.

This collection was processed and finding aid was written by Lisa Marie Garofali, who has a M.A. in History and 10 years of experience working in the YSU Archives and Special Collections.
