You say honey that we've been
born on wrong years well I guess
so. You was born to early and I too late.

But someday you will be for always
home
and then you can forget all about this.

In your letter of 13 you say
that if your coming home you will
send me a telegram I wish you would
don't worry I won't be afraid because
I know its from you. But sweetheart
honestly I wish you could come home.
And I'll also be very happy to see
my lover too.

my lover loves me but I can
assure you sweetheart I that I feel
the same about you and I always
will.

You say sweetheart that you want
to stay up my place I wish you

be able to stay here always or else well

to do make people laugh.

they are always fighting here with me but I
don't care what they say. Anyway
they are looking for trouble if they
don't leave me alone there will be some.

Last night sweetheart I was down
your brothers house and poor
fellow hes in bed again but he
is coming along fine. He got sick
just because of your cousin, aunt
or whatever she is to you that
lives in Aliquippa. Oh your brother
is mad as heck. I'll tell you
all about when you come home.

Today hon is Palm Sunday
so thats why I send you this cross.
Remember one you gave me last
year. I still have it and I still
have that stack of grass that you
gave me when you left. So when you
come home we will chew it.

Well sweetheart I guess I've
said enough now and I hope
I'll be seeing you very soon.
