You ask what I have to do with
my mothers brother in law nothing

honey would you really kill ^{me} you scar
me. Don't say that again because I
want to be yours for always if I didn't
I wouldn't be writing to you now.

Honestly sweetheart I really love
you very much and I mean it from

soon I wont get crazy ideas but I
think I'll go crazy. So I hope I'll
be seeing you soon and I have to tell
you lots of things.
