You feel sad honey but you should be very happy that you are still here and sometime soon I will be seeing you. I know you want to be home and so does everyone else want you to be

here but now you have to stay in army for awhile.
After the war is over you will be home always and
maybe sometimes when you get mad at me
I bet you will say I wish I was in the army.

Tonight hon I called your place and everybody
has a cold. But I guess it will go soon. Anyway
Mary told me she has something nice to tell me
that you wrote your brother. Now what did you tell
him you want to get married or something like
that. But she said to go see her that she will tell
me so maybe I'll go Sunday. I talked to Rita too
can you image she calls me Aunt Mary well
it sounds so nice maybe it soon will be true.

Well hon whis weather is crazy cold than
it gets warm. I hope it gets warm soon because I
don't like cold weather.
