A. University Affairs Committee

RESOLUTION TO RATIFY YOUNGSTOWN STATE UNIVERSITY ASSOCIATION OF PROFESSIONAL/ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF LABOR AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the three-year collective bargaining Agreement between the Association of Professional/Administrative Staff ("APAS") and Youngstown State University ("University") expires on June 30, 2021; and WHEREAS, collective bargaining between the APAS and the University has proceeded in a mutually advantageous manner; and

WHEREAS, a tentative collective bargaining Agreement for the three-year period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024 has been reached between the APAS and the University and the APAS union has voted to approve the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Youngstown State University does hereby ratify the collective bargaining Agreement between the APAS union and the University for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.
