B ritish composer Sir William Walton has been acclaimed as one of the most distinguished individualistic composers produced by England during the first half of the twentieth of But for a few years of training as an adolescent, Walton was primarily self-taught, which encound him to develop his own characteristic musical style. Best known for his film scores, Walton has posed numerous orchestral, choral and chamber works.

This majestic composition was commissioned by British Royalty for the coronation of King Gette VI in 1937. Walton was approached with the commission during a period in which he was posing an orchestral setting of William Dunbar's poetry. Walton selected a verse from one of Depoems which captures the regal and ceremonial nature of the installation of the British monarce Beauty bearing the Crown Imperial".

The Power of Rome and the Christian Heart (1947).....Percy Aldridge Graves (1882)

World-renowned piano virtuoso, collector of folk songs, and composer of the most promusic for bands, Australian-born Percy Grainger left a colorful and eccentric legacy for the who cherish his contribution to the literature for winds. His musical style combined compositional vations that pre-dated Stravinsky (irregular rhythms), Bartok (folk song collection), and Varese is tronic sounds) with a 19th century harmonic language. This unusual combination of technic however, did not achieve the critical acclaim that was granted to some of his contemporaries. Never less, his compositions demand considerable study and recognition.

This particular composition is not performed as often as some of his more famous works for the addition of several pianos and organ make this piece a particular challenge in coordinating required forces. The resolution of the logistical problems are rewarded, however, by a deeply memory musical experience.

Grainger based this work ostensibly on the struggle of the early Christians to practice their faither the reign of the Roman Empire. Underneath this concept, however, lies Grainger's discontain the "individual conscience as threatened or coerced by Forces of Authority". During the territer nage of World War I, Grainger could not justify the wastage of life for political intrigue, and we tressed by the conscription of peaceful men into combat. Grainger ultimately describes this competence as the "Individual Soul in direct conflict with the Powers that Be".

This historical movereferred to as "Nationalism", is best represented in Norway by Edvard Grieg. The national charactered to the folk music were superimposed upon an orthodox compositional technique that stemmed Grieg's training at Eastern European conservatories. He is best known as a composer of piano incidental music to plays, and lieder.

Greg's interest in the preservation of Norwegian folk music was sparked by his relationship with box composer, Rikard Nordraak. They had attended school together and were very supportive of ech others work. While studying in Rome, Grieg was informed of Nordraak's untimely death. He so moved by the loss of his friend that he wrote this funeral march for piano the very same day of an expression of his grief. The piece was later scored for orchestra and performed at Grieg's own remment.

Symphony No. 3 in C major (1886)..... "Organ Symphony" Movement II

The organ plays a prominent role in this symbut does not function as a solo instrument as it would in a concerto. This transcription successreproduces an orchestral timbre and captures the magnificence of the marriage between trumentalists and organ.





# YOUNGSTOWN STATE UNIVERSITY

## DANA SCHOOL OF MUSIC

The Dana School of Music began in 1869 as Dana's Musical Institute in Warren, Ohio. It was merged with Youngstown College in 1941.

The purpose of the school is to complement the general objectives of the University by providing intense professional training in music based on a thorough understanding of the fundamental skills and theory upon which all music rests, and to provide an opportunity for the non-music major to develop a background of musical knowledge.

The school is one of three departmental units in the College of Fine and Performing Arts, which is housed in Bliss Hall, where there are 80 acoustically controlled practice rooms, faculty studios, classrooms, rehearsal rooms and a recital hall with a seating capacity of 237. In addition, frequent use is made of Stambaugh and Powers Auditoriums.

### ABOUT THE ARTISTS

One of the few touring one-piano, four-hand teams in the United States, Boston pianists Barbara and Gerhardt Suhrstedt have been in the forefront of a revival of interest in the piano duet concert medium. They presented their first four-hand recitation 1979 at Tufts University and have specialized in the piano medium since that time. Since their New York debut at Merkin Concert Hall in 1982, the Suhrstedts have concertized extension throughout the United States and Canada. They have presented recitals for the Dame Myra Hess Series in Chicago, at the National Gallery of Arts and the Phillips Collection in Washington, DC and on the Bösendörfer Series at the Indianapolis Museum of Arts

When the couple performed for the American Liszt Society's Franz Liszt International Centenary Festival in 1986, they became the first piano duet team invited to perform for a Liszt Society annual festival. During the 1989-90 season, Barbara and Gerhardt presented a series of three concerts, "A Four-Hand Feast", at Boston's Isabella Stewart Gardner Museum. Last November, they were featured Artists/Clinicians for the 1990 Louisiana Music Teachers' Association State Convention. In March, the Suhrstedts will present the premiere performance of "Fantasy for Piano Duet Hazzard. They will celebrate the Mozart anniversary by including four-hand works of Mozart and his contemporaries such as Johann Christian Bach and Jan Ladislav Dussek on their 1991 concert programs.

Barbara Fetrow Suhrstedt is a native of Ohio and a graduate of the Oberlin Conservatory of Music, where her teacher was Jack Radunsky. While in Ohio, she also studied with George Haddad. Gerhardt Suhrstedt is originally from Charleston, South Carolina. He completed his undergraduate work at Furman University, where he was a student of David Gibson. The Suhrstedts met and married while attending graduate school at Boston University's School of the Arts. Their teachers in Boston include Béla Böszörmenyi-Nagy, Heinz Schröter, and Theodore Lettvin.

Current residents of Boston, Barbara and Gerhardt Suhrstedt have taught at several schools, including Tufts University and the South Shore Conservatory of Music. In addition to their formal concerts, they regularly present lectures and workshops on the piano duet medium for colleges and piano teachers' associations.

Barbara and Gerhardt Suhrstedt are Baldwin Piano Artists.

#### ABOUT OUR GUEST ARTIST

Multi-talented **Benny Golson** is an acclaimed musical artist, at home in nearly every idiom of modern music. He is a composer, arranger, lyracist, producer - and a saxophonist of world note. His influence has had an impact on jazz, middle-of-the road, rock-n-roll and on motion pictures, televison and records

Educated at Howard University, Mr. Golson began his jazz career in Philadelphia, his home, later shifting his activities to New York where he began to gain fame as a saxophonist, playing with such bands as Dizy Gillespie, Art Blakey, Earl Bostic, Lionel Hampton, Benny Goodman and even his own group. At the same time, as well as winning first place as the *new star* saxophonist 2 years straight in the *Downbeat* Magazine International Jazz Poll thus becoming number 7 in the world on his instrument, he also begain to gain fame as a composer also winning that same poll as the *new star* composer. His compositions, many of them standards now, have been recorded by many major jazz artists such as Quincy Jones, Oscar Peterson. The Modern Jazz Quartet, George Shearing, Cal Tjader, Miles Davis, John Coltrane, Carmen McRae, Dinah Washington, Anita O'Day, Mel Torme, Peggy Lee as well as others.

Soon after, he began writing and producing music for radio and television commercials, working with many of the major advertising agencies in the country. He is still engaged in this area, nationally. Later, his interests expanded to encompass middle-of-the-road and popular music, arranging and composing for artists like Diana Ross, Connie Francis, Eartha Kitt, Lou Rawls, Nancy Wilson, The Association, Mama Cass Elliot. Percy Faith, The Monkees and Ella Fitzgerald.

Mr. Golson gave up performing in 1967, devoting himself to writing music for television and feature films. Moving to Hollywood, he soon became involved in composing musical scores for "M\*A\*S\*H", "Ironside," "Mission Impossible," "Mod Squad," "Room 222," "The Partridge Family," "Mannix," "Run For Your Life," David Janssen's "Where It's At," "The Karen Valentine Show," pilots for ABC, CBS and others.

Accomplished and successful, Mr. Golson nevertheless felt the need to resume his career as a saxophonist. He began performing again in 1974 and has appeared regularly since in concerts and festivals around the world including Tokyo, Japan - Berlin, Germany - Montreux, Switzerland - London, England and Monterey, California. Since this resumption he has recorded albums, under his own name for Columbia Records as well as CBS/Sony in Japan, and is not only producing his own albums but albums for other artists as well
