THE DANA ARTISTS' SERIES 1966-67

The Dana School of Music of Youngstown University is proud to announce its fourth Dana Artists' Series. This year's series will feature five concerts with orchestra: an opera, an evening of ballet, an evening of concertos, and two choral concerts. There will be a total of twenty-one concerts and recitals featuring members of the Dana faculty and guest artists.

Although the number of orchestral and chamber music concerts has been increased, there has been no change in the price of a season patron ticket. It may still be purchased for a minimum contribution of \$10, or \$15 for a couple. Tickets to the individual concerts will be \$1 except for the ballet concert which will be \$2. Youngstown University students will be admitted free to all concerts upon presentation of their student activity cards. Admission for other students will be fifty cents to all concerts except the ballet concert.
