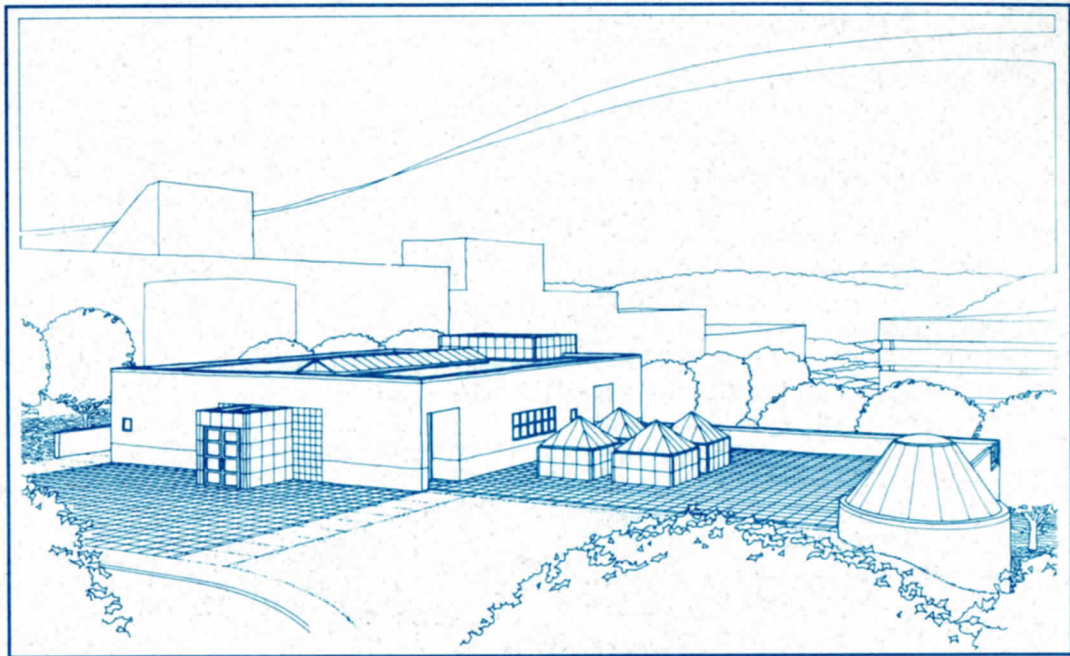

GROUNDBREAKING CEREMONIES

As the official art museum of Youngstown State University, the new John J. McDonough Museum of Art will embody a concept that is both pedagogical and aesthetic: the dynamic nature of the creative process. Art history instruction will take place alongside changing displays and installations in wide range of media.

The Museum will show current work by faculty and students, as well as exhibits of other colleges and universities, shows by community and regional artists, and innovative cross-disciplinary exhibits. Art history classes will be taught in the lecture hall of the Museum, and students interested in museum practice will have available hands-on experience in preparing, setting up and curating upcoming shows. In the longer term, the McDonough Museum will aid in the potential development of a University graduate program in museology.

The new McDonough Museum comes to YSU from the proceeds of the sale of a painting donated to the University by Dr. John J. McDonough, a Youngstown area physician and avid art collector. The State of Ohio will fund the balance of the \$2.6 million construction cost.

Plans for the museum were developed jointly by the New York design firm of Gwathmey and Siegel Associates Architects and Buchanan, Ricciuti and Balog Architects, Inc. of Youngstown.

The project is scheduled for completion in September 1991.

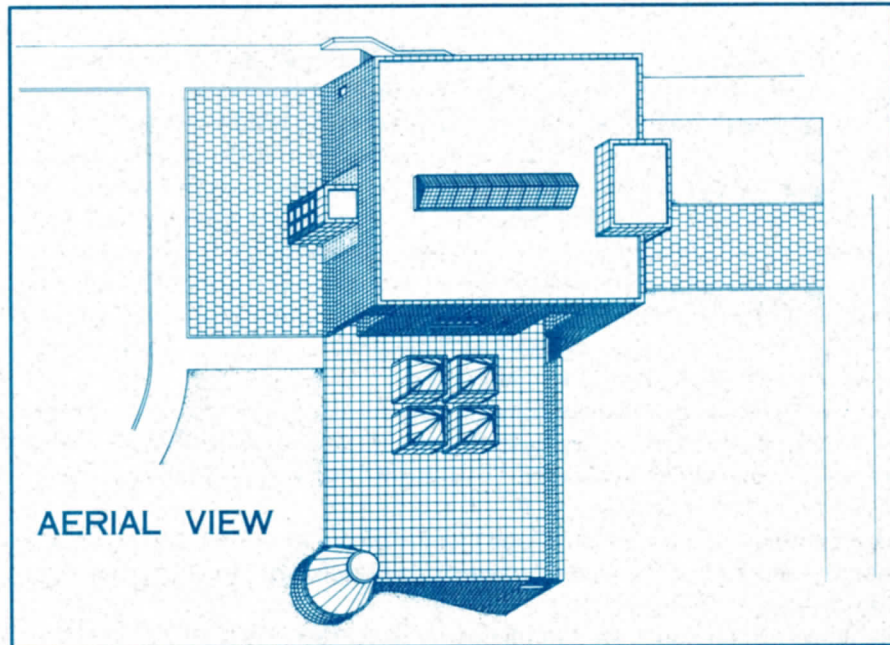
