necossanty by incest) in their hames, Brady, a feninist, pointed out. She said that $65 \%$ of the pros titutes in New York City had been ictims of incest.
Sne said that statistics reveal that one out of 100 females had been sexually assaulted by their
fathers. But, what is so startling, Brady said, is that this abuse is occurring in middle-class homes
with fathers who
Brady heavy drinkers. Brady admitted that her own father was a nurturing, loving

"He always said, "Who's it gonna hurt if we don't tell anyone?' I hated myself," Brady She
She said that each time she was sexually molested, she told
herself that this would be the last time. But it wis not.
Brady said she always.thought she was the guilty one - that it was somehow her fault. She added that she noticed none of
