

When asked why he chose this particular field, Quail said, "I wanted to do something where I wouldn't have to breathe but could work with my hands."


Quail finds his classes fulfilling both academically and spiritually. He said, "Yes, it's a tough course load but hey, I love it."







According to Tressel and Neil Yes, the group may look D., the band wouldn't exsist without their main rapper and number one dude, Phil 'Wildman" Hirsch.






