

YSU'S FIRST WOMAN ROTC COMMANDER—The command of the YSU Army Reserve Officer Training Corps of cadets was passed from cadet Lt. Col. Pete Fast to Cadet Lt. Col. Eileen Bradish in a ceremony held on the YSU campus. This is the first time in the 27-year history of the YSU cadet corps that a woman will command the ROTC battalion. Bradish is an active member of the Society of the Scabbard and Blade, a ROTC honor society, and is also a member of the Recondos, which stresses outdoor training and activities. She was recently one of four outstanding cadets selected to receive a regular Army commission upon graduation. She will be commissioned as a second lieutenant, United States Army transportation corps. Bradish is currently a senior at YSU, majoring in retail marketing and will graduate in August.
