

YSU promotes Clouse

Clouse has been promoted to assistant vice president for labor relations and director of classified personnel at YSU effective July 1, 1987, formally assuming additional responsibilities in the areas of negotiation and administration of agreements with the four bargaining units at the University.

He will provide assistance to YSU's vice president, personnel services, Dr. Taylor Alderman, in all aspects of labor relations and he will be designated the University's chief negotiator.

He has participated in all negotiations with non-faculty bargaining units since 1978. He will serve as YSU's liaison with the State Employment Relations Board and the State Personnel Board of Review and will continue to serve as director of classified personnel.
