

College Enrollment

An all-time high enrollment of 3,460 students at Youngstown College was announced recently by college officials. There are 2,440 day students and 1,020 evening students.

A survey of enrollment shows that there are 1,860 veterans registered in the college, with the ratio of men to women nearly five to one.

The youngest student is 15-year-old George Potor, of 474 Coitsville road, Campbell, a pre-medical student. The oldest student is 51 and the average age of students is just above 23.

The school of business administration leads in enrollment with 844 students. The school of engineering is second with 763 enrollees, and the school of education ranks third with 442 students.
