

# YSU on display Sunday

The University's year-long 75th anniversary celebration will be highlighted Sunday by the Diamond Jubilee Open House to showcase YSU's growth from a law class held at the YMCA to its present status as Ohio's fastest growing university.

Steve Grcevich, director of telecommunications and co-chairman of the open house, told media representatives Wednesday that the event will be "the biggest

assemblage ever on the YSU campus." Grcevich predicted 20-25,000 visitors.

The Open House will run from noon to 6 p.m. with free admission and free parking.

The celebration will feature special events from virtually every University department. The campus proper is being specially groomed for the event with 15,000 flowering plants ordered to enhance YSU's award-winning campus design.
