

Prof. Smith Awarded Philosophy Degree

Professor Elbert B. Smith, Jr., associate professor of history at Youngstown College, has been granted his doctor of philosophy degree in the winter convocation held at the University of Chicago.

Dr. Smith came to Youngstown College in September of 1949. He served with the U. S. Navy as a

communications and deck officer from 1942 to 1946, and received his master's degree from the University of Chicago in 1947. From then until September of 1949 he continued his doctorate studies at the University of Chicago while serving as an assistant in the University's history department.
